

Stratford Police Department News Release

For Immediate Release: Burglary Arrest

On Friday, December 13, 2013 officers from the Stratford Police Department responded to a burglary in progress on Kovach Drive. Upon arrival officers found that the house had in fact been entered. They also found that the suspects fled on foot, leaving their vehicle still running at the scene. One suspect was captured almost immediately. This suspect was identified as Joshua Roman age 19 of Stratford. Witnesses provided officers with descriptions of two other suspects who fled on foot.

The second suspect, Katiria Rivera age 33 of Stratford was apprehended by officers a short time later on Huntington Road. Katiria Rivera was found to be in possession of numerous articles of jewelry and cash money that was identified as items stolen from the residence on Kovach Drive.

The third and final party was apprehended on Nichols Avenue. This subject was identified as Davson Rivera age 22 of Stratford. At the time of arrest Davson Rivera was found to be in possession of stolen jewelry and a loaded firearm.

Subsequent investigation led to a search warrant for 22 Jackson Avenue which is where all three suspects reside. Upon serving the warrants numerous items including jewelry, computers, and stolen firearms and vehicles as well stolen Christmas presents were recovered. At this time the investigation is ongoing and the investigators are working with neighboring towns to identify owners of the stolen property. The arrests will help close numerous burglaries and larcenies which have occurred in this and other towns.

Currently Davson Rivera was charged with Burglary First degree, Interfering With An Officer, Criminal Possession Of A Firearm, Theft Of A Firearm and Carrying A Pistol Without A Permit. He was held on a \$250,000 dollar bond.

Katiria Rivera was charged with Burglary First, Interfering With An Officer and Criminal Trespass Second. She was held on a \$50,000 dollar bond.

Joshua Roman was charged with Conspiracy To Commit Burglary First. He was held on a \$5,000 dollar bond.
