For Immediate Release: Car Crashes Into House

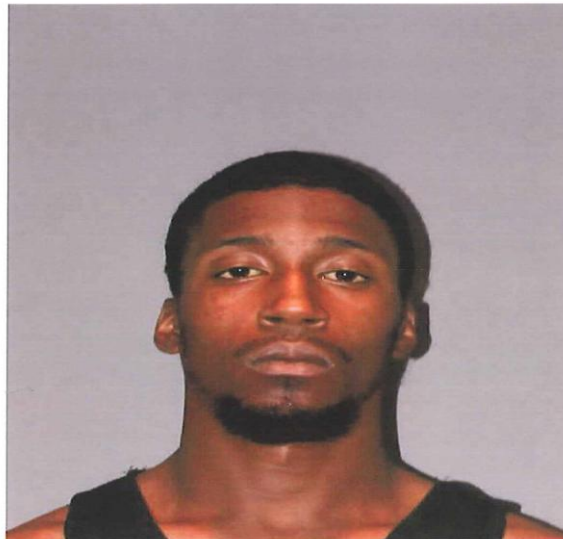
On 09-21-2013 Stratford Patrol Officers assisted Bridgeport with a pursuit which ended in this town. During the incident officers attempted to stop an Audi which had stolen license plates. The car left Bridgeport and traveled into the Town of Stratford. Stratford officers attempted to stop the vehicle for Bridgeport but alled off the pursuit due to the erratic driving of the operator. The Audi crashed a short while later and the Driver fled on foot to avoid arrest

When officer arrived on scene they learned that the car had crashed into a home on Mill Pond Lane. The driver, Demarcus Murphey, age 21 of Ansonia was apprehended a shot distance from the crash by officers. Murphey had his wife and step child in the car with him during the incident.

Murphy was charged with Reckless Endangerment 1st, Speeding, Risk of Injury to Minor and Engaging Officers in Pursuit, Driving Under Suspension, Operating and Unregistered Motor Vehicle, Operating an Uninsured Motor Vehicle, Theft of a License Plate and Evading Responsibility with Injuries.
