

Stratford Police Department News Release

For Immediate Release: Burglary Arrest

On 09-19-2013 Officers responded to 484 Columbus Avenue to investigate a report of an attempted burglary. The homeowner reported that an unknown subject entered her home, but she scared him off and he ran through some adjoining yards. The suspect was reportedly dropped off by a white Ford Explorer with South Carolina License Plates. This vehicle and subjects matching their descriptions were reported in the area of other recent burglaries in this and surrounding towns.

Officers located and stopped the vehicle which was occupied by Cameron Random age 21 of Derby, on Garibaldi Avenue in this town. During the stop officers located the party on foot hiding behind a home on Priscilla Lane. He was identified as Love Millet age 21 of Bridgeport. After confirming that the two parties were responsible for the attempted burglary they were taken into custody. During the investigation Millet was found to have jewelry in his pocket from a second reported burglary at 795 Birdseye Street. A television stolen in the Birdseye burglary was later located in the luggage compartment of Random's vehicle.

Millet was charged with Burglary in the Third Degree and Larceny in the Sixth Degree Interfering with an Officer and Criminal Impersonation. He was held on a \$100,000 bond and arraigned in court on 09-20-2013.

Love was also found to have a warrant for his arrest issued by the court for Violation of Probation.

Random was charged with Conspiracy to Commit Burglary in the Third Degree and Larceny in the Fifth Degree. He was held on a \$100,000 bond and arraigned in court on 09-20-2013.

Investigation is ongoing.
