For Immediate Release: Burglary Arrest

On 10-09-2013 officers responded to the area of 70 Temple Street to investigate a report of a burglary in progress. Upon arrival officers learned that the suspect had fled the area in a green Honda. Officers also received a report of an attempted burglary at 22 Temple Street.

Patrol officers located the suspect vehicle and upon signaling the vehicle to stop the operator, Peter Marino age 40 of Stratford engaged officers in pursuit. He fled west on Connecticut Avenue into Bridgeport where he crashed into a pick-up truck and was quickly apprehended.

Marino was identified as the person who broke into the home at 70 Temple and he admitted to the attempted burglary at 22 Temple. Marino was charged with the following crimes.

For 77 Temple Street Marino was charged with Home Invasion, Burglary in the Second Degree, Criminal Mischief in the Second Degree, Reckless Driving and Engaging Officer in Pursuit. He was held on a \$200,000 dollar bond.

For 22 Temple Street Marino was charged Criminal Attempt at Burglary in the Third Degree and Criminal Mischief in the Third Degree. He was held on a \$50,000 dollar bond.

Marino also had a re-arrest warrant issued for Violation of Probation. He was remanded to custody and held on \$15,000 dollar bond for the warrant.

Marino is scheduled to appear in Bridgeport Superior Court on 10-18-2013 for the charges.
