

Stratford Press Release

Several months ago, the Stratford Police Narcotics Vice and Intelligence Unit started an investigation into the illegal activities of David Vereen D.O.B 06/06/80, who resides at 175 Cannon Dr. within the Town of Stratford. During the investigation, Narcotics Detectives discovered that Vereen was selling large amounts of Crack Cocaine and powder Cocaine within the Town of Stratford and surrounding cities.

On 08/05/2013, Narcotics Detectives with the assistance of the Stratford Police Patrol Division K-9 Units, executed a Search Warrant at Vereen's residence located at 175 Cannon Dr. Stratford CT. Inside the residence, Detectives discovered approximately 300.1 grams of powder cocaine, 20.1 grams of Crack Cocaine, (30) roxycodone pills, and several items used for the cutting, packaging and processing of Narcotics. Vereen was taken into custody and charged with:

(3) Three Counts of Sales of Narcotics in violation of CGS 21a-278(b) with a Court set bond of \$750,000. Vereen was issued a Court date of 08/15/2013.

In addition, Vereen was also charged with the following: Possession WITS more than ½ Ounce of Cocaine C.G.S 21a-278(a), Possession of Narcotics With Intent to Sell C.G.S 21a-278(b), Operating a drug Factory C.G.S 21a-277(c) and Risk of Injury to a Minor C.G.S 53-21. For these charges, Vereen was issued an additional bond of \$250,000 and a Court date of 08/15/2013.

Vereen was unable to post his total bond of \$1,000,000 and is being held in custody
